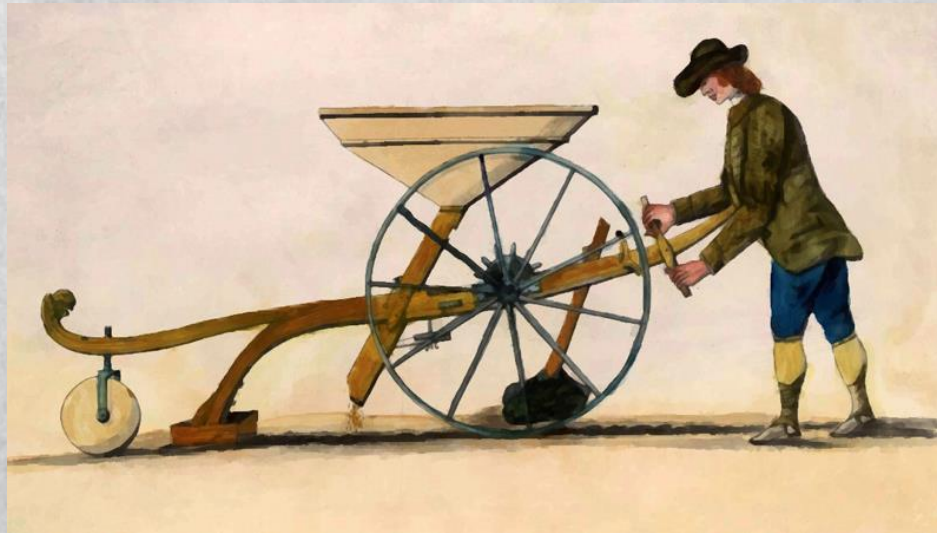

List some of the changes that happened during the Agricultural Revolution in Britain.



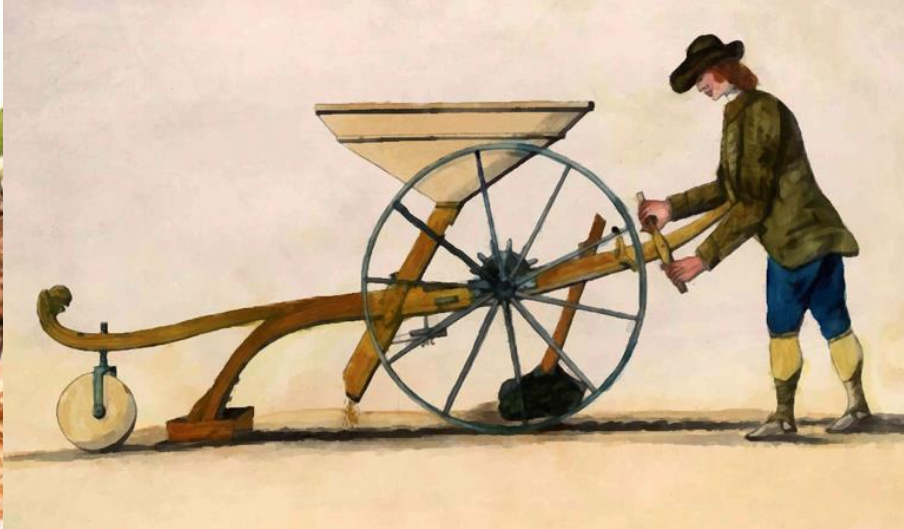


1760s: Robert Bakewell had a go at selective breeding of cattle and sheep.

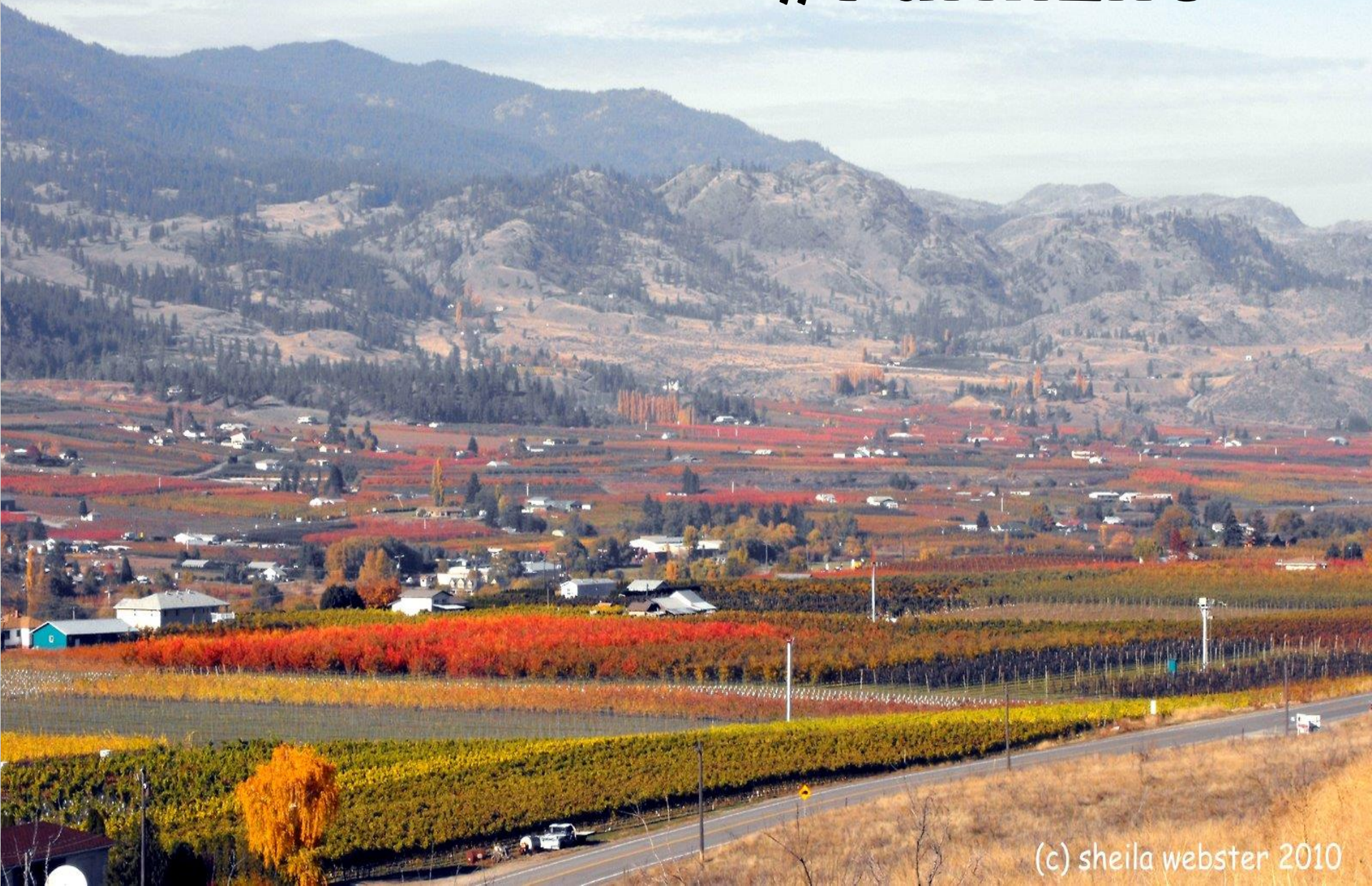

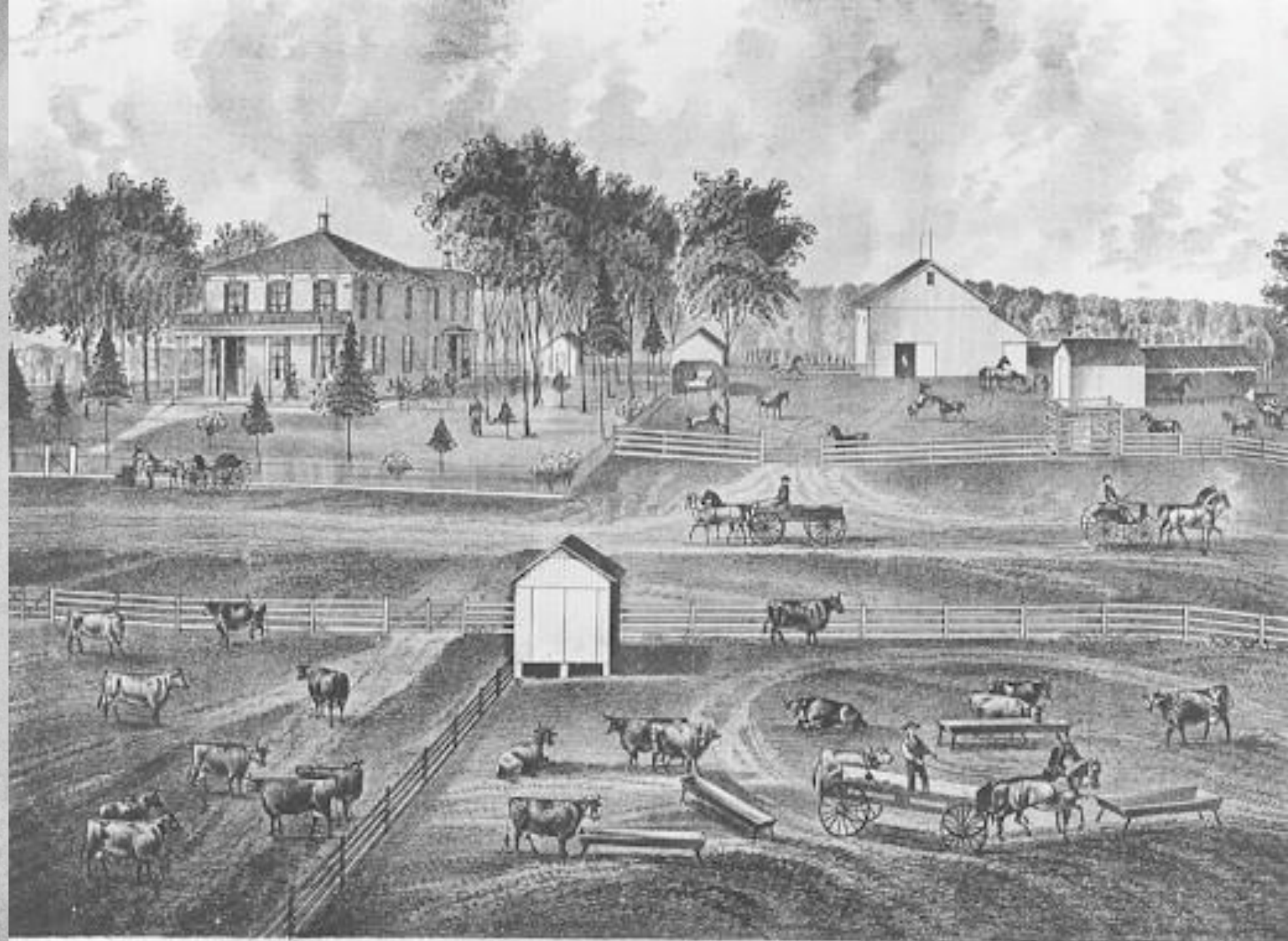

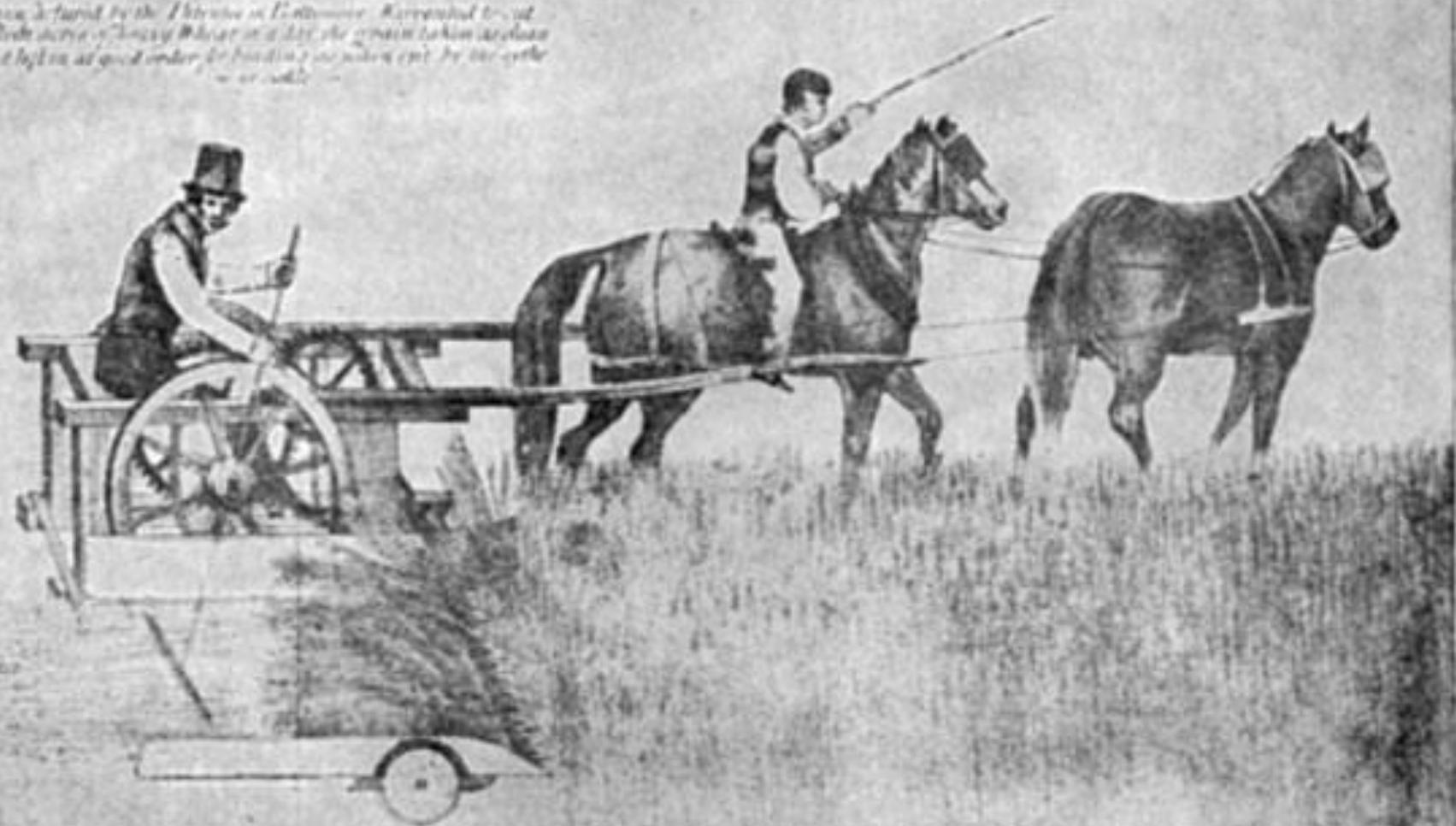
