# THE CELTS

Throughout the classroom is a variety of information about the Ancient Celtic peoples. You will move around the classroom to learn more about the life of the Celts. At each station, you will fill in your **graphic organizer** (what you learned). You must also choose **4 station activities** to complete.

# **SUMMATIVE ASSIGNMENT**

Your final task will be to show what you have learned about the Celts in some way. You can choose to focus on one aspect of Celtic life, or on several- it is up to you!

## Ideas for what you could create:

•	A Postcard	Imagine that you have traveled back in time and are spending time living with the Celts. Describe what life would be like.
•	A Skit	Team up with some of your classmates (no more than 4) and create a skit which shows us about the life of the Celts.
•	Journal Entry	Write a journal entry detailing life with the Celts.
•	Comic Strip	Create a comic strip that shows some aspect of Celtic life.
•	Art/drawing	Create a piece of artwork/drawing that demonstrates your understanding of Celtic life or tradition.
•	News Article	Write a news/magazine article about the Celts. (Could be from a Roman point of view!)
•	Poem	Write a poem that has to do with Celtic life.
•	Time Travel Brochure/Ad	Create a brochure or advertisement for historical time travel– back to the age of the Celts!
•	Something else!	If you have another great creative idea just let me know $\ensuremath{\mathfrak{O}}$
