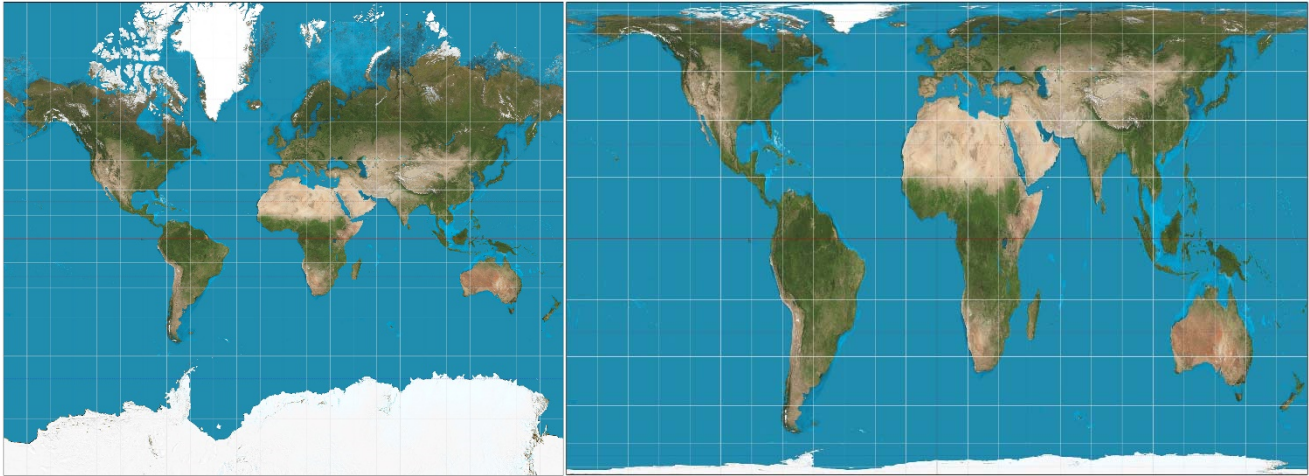

Google Maps

Use the **Google Maps** app on your station's iPad, or on your phone, to find the following:

1. Driving from Burns Lake to Vancouver

- a. How many kilometres is the drive from Burns Lake to Vancouver, if you take the route through Kamloops?
- b. Approximately how long would it take you (in hours and minutes) to drive this?

2. **Stopover in Kamloops:** You have arrived in Kamloops, and are tired of driving. You have decided to stay the night there and continue your drive in the morning.

- a. Use Google Maps to find a restaurant that you would like to eat dinner at. Write down the address of the restaurant.
- b. Use Google Maps to find a hotel/motel to stay at. Write down the address of the hotel, as well as the phone number.
- c. How many kilometres is your hotel/motel from the restaurant?

3. **Change of Route:** You've met some fellow travellers and decided to change your destination from Vancouver to Calgary. Now you will be driving from Kamloops to Calgary.

- a. How many kilometres is the drive from Kamloops to Calgary?
- b. Approximately how long would it take you (in hours and minutes) to drive this?
- c. List four national parks that you will drive through on this route.
- d. List one place where you could stop to go skiing along this route.
