The Sniper: Questions

1. Critical Literacy

Notice how the sniper **dehumanizes*** the other sniper by thinking of him as “the enemy” (page 118). If the author had used another word besides “enemy,” how might that have changed the meaning?

**To dehumanize = to demonize the enemy, making them seem less than human and not worthy of humane treatment.*

2. Comprehension

Compare how the sniper feels before shooting the enemy sniper (p.119) with how he feels afterwards (p.120).

3. Drawing Conclusions

Why do you think the sniper has the reaction that he does, after shooting the enemy sniper (p.120).

b) What is **situational irony**?

5. Explain what the irony revealed at the end of this story is.
