
## **Paragraphs: Transition Words**

When writing paragraphs, it is important to help the reader by providing **TRANSITION WORDS**. Transition words are used to link sentences and ideas. If you use them correctly, your writing will be easier to understand and more mature.



## **Sentence Examples Using Transitions**

Transition Type	Example Sentences
Adding information	We have seen the movie twice, <b>and</b> now we want to see it again. Students should be on time. <b>Furthermore</b> , they must be prepared.
Giving examples/clarifying	He often eats strange foods. <b>For instance</b> , he once ate cow brains. I love fruit. <b>In particular</b> , I like bananas, pineapple, and berries.
Showing a contrast	Bill earned an A on his essay, <b>but</b> Susan got a B. She hates housecleaning. <b>On the other hand</b> , she doesn't mind cooking.
Showing a comparison/similarity	Math was hard for me in high school. <b>Likewise</b> , it is hard in college. Rock climbing takes much practice and skill. <b>In the same way</b> , learning to write well requires a great deal of practice.
Showing a time sequence	First, she went to the grocery store. Second, she put many tasty treats in her cart. Finally, she paid for her items.
Showing a cause & effect	She studied hard for the exam. <b>As a result,</b> she earned an "A."  I forgot to set my alarm. <b>As a consequence,</b> I was late for school.
